We appreciate how difficult this is for you, and we would rather your child arrives a little later than not at all.

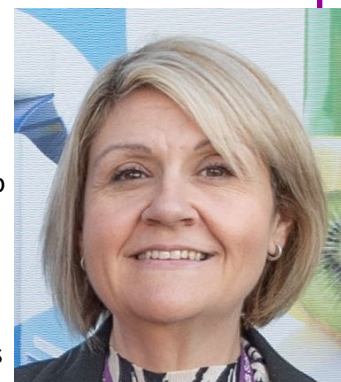

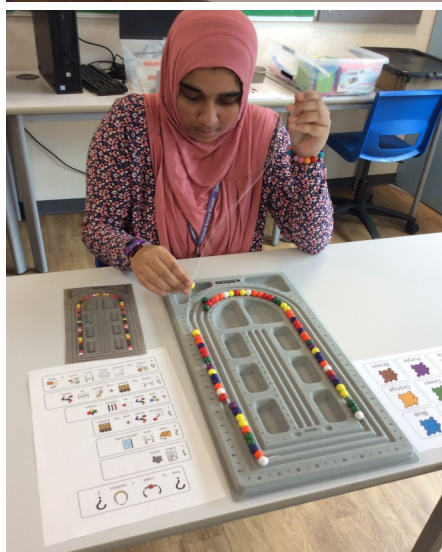
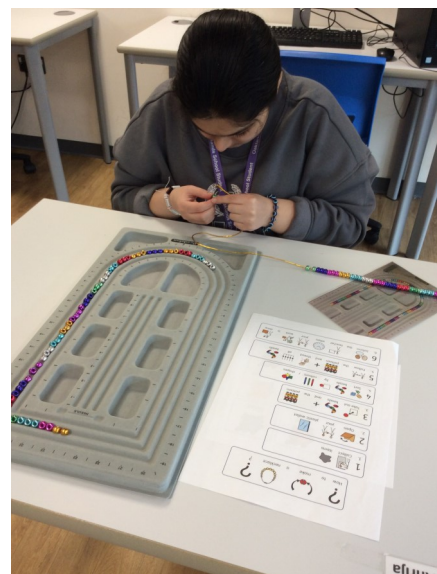
Oaklands Has Talent






